- A. Trahan Mr. Harding
  - 1. Everyone is working hard, developing new learning plans but it has been a great collaboration between the Dewing/Heath Brook and the North Street/Trahan
  - 2. Report cards are being sent out tomorrow, advocating for parents to get on Aspen earlier to troubleshoot
